# HOW TO MAKE A VISTOR FEEL COMFORTABLE AND WELCOME

**WALK**  
**1**

Too often guests end up parking way out because the closer spots are taken. Take the parking spaces near the back or on the sides and leave the good spots for others.

**MIDDLE**  
**5**

Move to the middle so guests don't have to walk over you. Trying to find a seat is part of what keeps new-comers away - it's hard enough to come in and just sit down!

**PICK UP**  
**2**

If you invited someone to your home, you would spend a little effort making the place look nice. If you see trash, be a pal and pick it up! If you make a mess, clean it up.

**LOST?**  
**6**

If someone looks like they don't know where to go, they probably don't! Step out of your comfort zone and ask if you can help. Don't just tell them where to go--SHOW THEM!

**THREE**  
**3**

Challenge yourself to talk only to those you don't know for the first 3 minutes after service. We want to let guests know they are noticed and welcome!

**FORM**  
**7**

Guests may be overwhelmed by the newness of their experience. Try conversation using good FORM-Ask about Family, Occupation, Recreation, and Motivation.

**SMILE**  
**4**

A smile may be all a person needs to feel welcome! Guests feel more at ease when they see smiling people!

**INVITE**

When saying goodbye to a guest, it's simple to say, "Thank you for being here! We'd love to have you back!" Let's make our church a place where people belong!
