Week of September 15 Pencils, Pens, Crayons Markers, Coloring Books I was caught off guard last week as I sat down to study for our Youth Midweek message. We are currently going through the Fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-23) and what that fruit looks like being produced in the lives of Disciples of Christ.
