The Personnel Committee will be presenting you with 2 recommendations at the Business Meeting on January 26.

1) We recommend that EBC call Nicholas Callen to be our Minister of Worship. We recognize God's call on Nic's life to serve in vocational ministry. We have been impressed with his sincerity, maturity and thoughtfulness in leading worship. There will be a time for those involved in our worship ministry to meet with Nicholas at 4:00 p.m. that evening to ask him questions and hear his vision for ministry. At 5:00 p.m. there will be a church-wide Meet and Greet with Nicholas in the Church Atrium for you to visit and get to know him better.

2) We recommend that EBC call Jake Taylor as an Associate Minister. Jake has been serving in the role of Youth Intern since last summer. He has served our students and our church well. We recognize God's call on his life and his desire to serve in vocational ministry. Since we are currently without a Minister to Families, and have not received any viable applicants, we need help preparing for Children's activities for the summer and the coming year. Jake would assist the church staff and Children's Ministry Team in preparing for those activities as well as continuing to serve in our Student and College Ministries. Jake's pay would come from the budgeted money for the Minister to Families line item. We plan to re-evaluate and renew our search for the position in the Fall.
