We are about to enter uncharted territory. The second half of the book of Daniel is **apocalyptic literature** which is a very different genre than the narratives from the first half of the book. I don't recall ever teaching from an apocalyptic section of the Bible - so this will be a new experience for me. Apocalyptic literature is strange - it's filled with bizarre images, symbolic numbers, and is rarely chronological. I know that many of you pray for me on a regular basis - for which I am incredibly grateful. Would you ask God in the coming weeks to grant me understanding and insight on how to present Daniel 7-12 to our Church Family? 2 Timothy 3:16-17 tells us that all Scripture is profitable for us to study and that God ordains it to help grow and equip us for good works. Please ask God to grow and equip our Church through our study of Daniel chapters 7-12.

As I mentioned before the sermon yesterday, I'm challenging all of our adult members to come pray with us one Wednesday night a month. This Fall we will be meeting in the Worship Center to Pray and Sing Hymns on Wednesday nights at 6:00. Will you consider joining us for one hour once a month? It won't be easy. Prayer is hard work. But it will be worthwhile. Praying with God's people is one of my favorite parts of the week. There is a unity and shared purpose in corporate prayer that we don't get from other places.

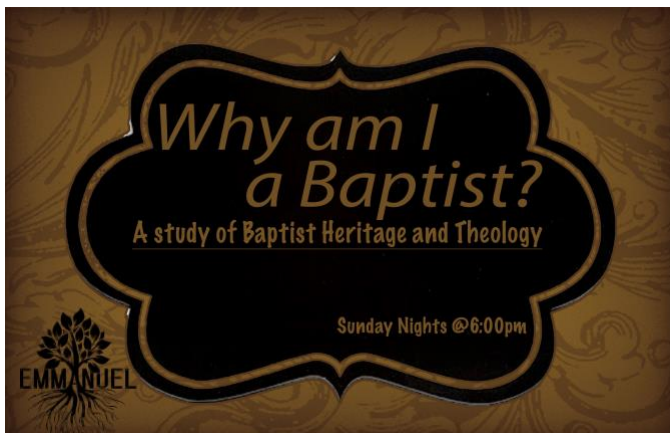
Emmanuel Family
