This coming Sunday night will be our last lesson this Fall on Baptist History and Distinctives. The series has been good, but it's also been a little overwhelming. My study time each week has uncovered so much more that I didn't know about our history as Baptists. Figuring out what to share and what to leave out has been a challenge each week. If you want to dig into this topic further, I'd highly recommend "The Baptist Story" by Chute, Finn, and Haykin. It's a textbook, so it reads a little dry, but it's a well-presented, condensed version of Baptist history. As we've talked through Baptist Distinctives, some important issues have surfaced for our Church Family. In particular, the Baptist Distinctive of Regenerate Church Membership has led to conversations about why our Membership Roll has 677 names on it, yet we only have 160 members present on any given Sunday. Our deacons have started considering this concern and I hope that in the coming months they will bring a recommendation to our Church with a plan to reconnect with our 500 absent members. We need to locate them and invite them back into being active members of our Family. Pray for your ministry staff and your deacons as we consider these things.

As we consider how to reconnect with missing members, I feel like it would be appropriate for us to study the purpose and value of church membership from the Bible. So I'm planning to lead us through a study on Sunday mornings in the month of November on why Church Membership Matters. As you study your Bibles on this topic, I'd love to hear what you're learning.
