CAMP INFORMATION

Camp Dates: June 20-23, 2022

EBC Kids is excited to host your kids at camp this summer. This packet of information is designed to help you know how to help your child prepare for camp, and what they'll experience at camp. Thank you for allowing us to be a part of your child's life in what we are praying will be a truly transformational experience.

WHAT WILL YOUR KID BE LEARNING?

OUR CAMP THEME

Everyone's life is LOUD about something. Whether we try to or not, we all stand for something. Some people are known for the sports teams they love, while others are known for what they are good at. Our lives are LOUDest about the things we love the most.

EBC Kids at PreTeen Camp will challenge kids to consider what their lives are LOUD about. We will learn that if we want to be known for our relationship with God, we need to know Jesus. Romans 1:16 teaches us that the good news about Jesus isn't something to be ashamed about — it is the power to save us from our sin! What is your life LOUD about?

DAILY BIBLE STUDY FOCUSES

DAY 1: OUR LIVES ARE LOUD

Luke 10:27 "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind", and "your neighbor as yourself."

DAY 2: GOD IS LOUD ABOUT YOU!

Luke 15:7 "I tell you, in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who don't need repentance."

DAY 3: BE LOUD ABOUT JESUS

Luke 8:16 "No one, after lighting a lamp, covers it with a basket or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a lamp stand so that those who come in may see its' light."

COST: \$50 (This is EBC's discounted price. The regular cost is \$90. Through gifts to the church specifically for kids ministry we are able to offer this lower price)

CONDUCT: The Code of conduct for Preteen camp is intended to assist the many diverse churches and children at camp to have a safe and enjoyable camp experience, while growing in their faith. EBC Kids PreTeen camp is a Christian camp designed to help Children to know and follow God, so the code of conduct prioritized personal encouragement and issues related to a child's faith development in Jesus.

EBC Kids PreTeen camp does not condone or encourage any activity on grounds that would humiliate any camper, including initiation, hazing, and/or pranks. Furthermore, EBC Kids Preteen camp will not tolerate any activity that would harm any camper such as violence or abuse.

CABINS: Church groups remain together within assigned doors based on group size. Girls are not allowed in the boys' dorm; boys are not allowed in the girls' dorm.

CURFEW: Campers must be inside their cabins for evening cabin devotionals by 9:30 p.m.

INSURANCE: The camp insurance, included with registration, is a secondary insurance policy that supplements your primary insurance coverage.

ILLNESS: EBC Kids Preteen camp will have a Camp Nurse on duty all week.

ATTIRE: While we understand the desire for fashionable attire, we require campers and sponsors to wear modest clothing. Modesty is a biblical principle and helps keep people focused on the important things at camp (1 Timothy 2:9-10; 4:12)

ATTIRE GUIDELINES (aka Dress Code):

- Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.
- Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language, pictures, or innuendos.
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses without coverup.
- Shorts/dresses/skirts must be of modest length. Note: Modest length can be generally defined as extending to just beyond the fingertips, which in general is no shorter than a 5-inch to 7-inch inseam.

SWIMMING ATTIRE:

A cover-up must be worn to and from the pool, and T-shirts must be worn over two-piece swimsuits.

SWIMMING POOL: A certified lifeguard is on duty at the swimming pool. Life jackets are NOT provided for campers, but campers may bring them to camp. Poor swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pool.

HIKING: Hiking is only permitted in the afternoon during recreation time and only with adult sponsors. Due to the extreme heat in the afternoon, hikers must bring a bottle of water with them for the hike. Other food and drink items are not permitted on the mountains. Close-toed shoe are required for hiking (no exceptions).

CONCESSIONS: A concession stand is available during free time. All items in the concession stand are \$1.25 each.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES: EBC Kids PreTeen Camp has emergency procedures in place for accidents, fire, intrusion, and severe weather.

The rules and regulations for EBC Kids PreTeen Camp @ Southwestern Baptist Churches Assembly camp exist for the safety and well-being of all our participants, as well as the protection of the camp and its environment.

I understand that it is the responsibility of Emmanuel Baptist Church to obtain permission for treatment or to limit participant's recreational activities because of a stated medical condition.

Participant, _____ will be attending various EMMANUEL BAPTIST CHURCH (EBC) sponsored activities during the January 1st, 2022 – December 31st, 2022. In the event the participant should need emergency medical care or attention, the EBC leadership, or any of its agents or employees is hereby authorized to consent to the provision of such emergency medical care, including without limitation, medical, dental, surgical care or hospitalization, to the participant as is recommended or suggested by a physician, nurse, surgeon or other health care professional.

If such emergency care is provided to the participant, the participants parents/guardian understand(s) that the participants health insurance information will be given to the health care professional and that any expenses not covered by the participants insurance shall be the responsibility of said participants parents/guardian. Participants parent/guardian understand(s) that EBC will not be obligated to pay either the health care professional or the participant's parents for any medical expenses incurred on behalf of the participant.

There are instances when third party contractors are used to operate and supervise various events and activities. In those instances where third party contractors are used, the participant and parent/guardian agrees that EBC is not responsible for the action of these third party contractors. The participant and parent/guardian further agrees

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that EBC is not liable for the actions or activities of other participants participating in events or activities operated by third party contractors.

I understand that the risk of injury from any recreational activity is significant, including, but not limited to, the potential for permanent paralysis and death. While particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. I knowingly and freely assume all risk, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence, and assume full responsibility for the my child's (my) participation in or observation of such recreational activity.

In consideration of my child (myself) being accepted by EBC for participation in MINISTRY TRAVEL AND ACTIVITIES, we (I), being 21 years of age or older, do for ourselves (myself) (and for and on behalf of my child-participant if said child is not 21 years of age or older) do hereby waive, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless EBC, their agents or employees, against any and all cause of action, rights, claims or suits which I or my child may have against EBC or their agents or employees as a result of personal injury to my child (myself), sickness, or death, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the undersigned and the child-participant that occur while said child (self) are participating in any EBC ministry activity, including, but not limited to: (1) injuries arising from my child's (my) participation in or observation of recreational activities at EBC ministry events and (2) injuries arising from the decision of the leadership of EBC or any of their agents or employees to consent to the provision of emergency medical care to my child (myself).

- Authorization and permission is hereby given to EBC to furnish any necessary transportation, food, and lodging for this participant.
- The undersigned agree to hold harmless and indemnify EBC, its directors, employees, and agents, for any liability sustained by EBC as the result of negligent, willful, or intentional acts of said participant, including expenses attendant thereto.
- Should it be necessary for the participant to return home due to medical reasons, disciplinary action, or otherwise, we (I) assume the responsibility for all transportation costs.
- I understand that my child's (my) image may be included in a video or in photographs that may be made during EBC activities. I understand that a promotional or highlight video may be available for distribution. I consent that my child's (my) image may appear on videos, promotional resources, EBC endorsed websites, etc.
- I give authority and permission to EBC and any of their staff or agents to inspect my child's (my) belongings while on EBC activities.
- I understand that EBC is a place where participants seek counsel and advice from adult leaders, staff, counselors and others. I hereby consent to my child receiving spiritual and emotional counsel during EBC activities.
